RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds in Special Event Accounts.

National Night Out is a free city event, open to the public, and held annually on the first Tuesday of every August, with this year's being held on August 6, 2019 at various locations throughout the City. The events are coordinated through many Council Offices with the assistance of the San Jose Police Department and other City Departments. This is a national effort held in collaboration with a wide variety of individuals, neighborhood and business associations, community-based organizations, schools, and community volunteers.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the Rules and Open Government Committee and City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In compliance with existing fundraising disclosure requirements, all participating Council Offices will report any solicitations made and donations received for the event in the Councilmembers'
