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BACKGROUND

Civic Engagement Through Technology Initiative Update

Staff requests adding the Facebook/YouTube Livestream Pilot Update item to the Smart Cities and Service Improvements Committee June 6, 2019 agenda. The pilot ended in April 2019, and staff would like to present the results of the pilot and recommendations on next steps.

Business Process Automation and E-signatures

Staff requests dropping the Business Process Automation and e-Signatures item due to procurement delays.
