BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds in Special Event Accounts.

The Muir/Hammer Dumpster Day was held on May 11, 2019 along Scossa Ave. next to Second Start Pine Hill School and sponsored by Councilmember Foley. This special event was a neighborhood clean-up event that is free and open to the members of the specified neighborhood.

ANALYSIS
