BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds in Special Event Accounts.

The Little Branham/Rosswood Dumpster Day was held on May 18, 2019 along Emiline Drive next to Little Oak Elementary School and sponsored by Councilmember Foley. This special event was a neighborhood clean-up event that is free and open to the members of the specified neighborhood.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>
