Background


Summary of First (2015) Four-Year Review

- November 2015 December 2016
- Six Task Force meetings
- Major policy changes recommended by Task Force
 - Reduction in planned job growth
 - Establishment of more achievable J/ER
 - Increase growth capacity in Downtown through DTS2040 update
 - New policies to facilitate affordable housing

 - e) Other Urban Village Policy Amendments (Village Planning Policy IP-5.5 and Signature Project Policy IP-5.10)

City Council Proposed Items

- Explore allowing parcels designated Residential Neighborhood to redevelop to 2-4 units with certain parameters
- Allow Task Force discussion of long-term future of North and Mid-Coyote Valley
- Explore reworking or closing the Evergreen-East Hills Development Policy
- Consider modifications to the UGB along Santa Teresa ridge
- Review impact of form based code within Urban Village Implementation Framework
- Bring back Task Force recommendations to Council in August 2019
