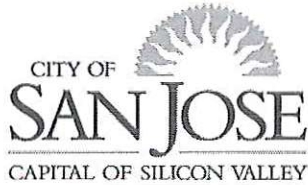

RE: Recommended City Council support of a Study of Vacant Homes

Dear Honorable Mayor Liccardo and City Council,

We, the members of the Housing and Community Development Commission, urge you to support a study of vacant homes and what impact they have on the supply and price of housing in San Jose.

Based on 2017 data gathered by American Community Survey, there are potentially 11,952 vacant homes in San Jose. If we factor out the homes that have a clear reason for why they are vacant, including those that are for rent, for sale, or for occasional use, there still remains 4,184 homes where there is no clear reason for the vacancy.

There is no doubt that we are in a housing crisis, and a significant part of this issue is that there are not enough homes to meet the great demand. While the data above needs to be verified, having even a fraction of these homes become available to be rented or sold can have a significant impact on our housing crisis. We believe that this potential should be studied, and if there are a significant number of homes that are vacant and are not being put to use, then we should begin exploring potential policy solutions to address this.

Our recommendation is to study this issue.

Subject: UPRR train horn nuisance | Request to create quiet zones

Dear Mayor Liccardo and Councilmembers,

I would like to bring your attention to an issue that has now been plaguing the residents of San Jose for more than a few months now, which are the late night train horns by trains operating on the Union Pacific Railway line which goes through the city. We are aware that residents of Downtown are particularly affected by the noise.

Studies have shown that loud noises are responsible to increase the risk of heart attacks among elders. Loud noises in the middle of the night lead to sleep deprivation and low productivity among adults and working population. In short, the blaring horns of the trains severely affect the quality of life of all residents living alongside the UPRR railway lines.

I'm well aware of the hearing that took place in the city hall earlier this month and I'm utterly disappointed at the complete lack of empathy of the UPRR representatives towards the residents. It is certainly not unreasonable to expect quiet hours in our neighborhood at least during night times after 10.00 PM. I trust the city leaders to use every tool at our disposal including legal action against UPRR.

Legal action, however is a time consuming process and does not always lead to desired outcomes. I think it is about time the city takes matters into its own hands and move towards creating quiet zones near railroad crossings at all populated areas within city limits. I understand and realize that this could take a few months, but this seems to be the right time to get started.

I am a resident at a townhome at the Branham-Monterey road intersection and one among the affected citizens. I believe the city is planning to create quiet zones at Downtown intersections and I believe the zones which lie outside downtown should certainly be considered in this process. Specifically, these intersections:

1. Monterey-Skyway
2. Monterey-Branham
3. Monterey-Chynoweth

Creating a quiet zone to include the three intersections listed above should not be an issue since all three lie within half a mile of each other. I sincerely hope that the city leaders will look into this matter as soon as possible and treat this with high priority as this severely affects the health of a significant number of residents. Please feel free to reach out to us if we are needed to resolve this and any other issue that affects our community.

I hope, my two following letters, can be of good thought, in what may be, city govt. get away time. - blair.

Dear city govt. and community of San Jose,

Items 2.12 & 2.13, the San Jose Sports Authority, is to be granted, over \$400,000, to look for, high-profile sporting events, for the future of San Jose.

I hope, we are all understanding, important lessons, studies, and reports, on how the December 4th, city council meeting, was handled.

As there was pressure, of the college football playoffs, happening in San Jose, around the same time.

There is a greed, to high profile sporting events, that tends to lead local communities, into difficult, non-progressive decision-making, that will have to be better addressed, in the future.

I do not doubt, there was some worried events, in the lead up to, the Dec. 4, city council meeting, on the future of Google, in San Jose.

But I feel, it could be argued, the mayors response was over-reactive, in considering the knowledge and friendships, he can have, with the protestors and regular activists, of our community,

His over-reactiveness, may have been in part, with the preparations, of the college football playoffs,

in what can be, the decision making powers, of the mayor, during emergency and violent extremist events.

I also hope, by December 4th, 2019, city council, city government, protesters themselves, and even myself, can be able to review, how we have matured, in the past year.

I feel these are some important ideas, in how to address, the problems of greed. money, ego, and prestige, that is at the heart, of high-profile sporting events, for a community.

Item 2.27, criminal asset forfeiture funds.

I have tried to say it before, there is an important list, of good, new, ideas and studies, in law enforcement and incarceration practices, that should be thought of, in making decisions, at this time.

And, at least noted, when these issues, are talked about.

Items 2.36 - 2.39. approval of dumpster days.

And finally, I have talked often recently, that I feel there can be, some interesting, good communication, within a local neighborhood,

by learning how, a Saturday morning dumpster day, can be advertised, as a shared experience - for those with homes, and those who are houseless, within a local San Jose neighborhood.

Better conversations, between people in local neighborhoods, can create, an overall, safer, more helpful dialogue, for the entire city.

Dear Mayor Liccardo, Mr. Sykes, Councilmember Esparza, members of the City Council and staff:

Save Our Trails: Connecting Santa Clara County Communities is a California Not-for-Profit Corporation whose mission is *"To promote trails in Santa Clara County for the benefit and enjoyment of all."*

We noted in the recent memorandum by Kim Walesh and Matt Cano (File 19-216) *"authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute of a memorandum of understanding with Sharks Ice"* that the **Three Creeks Trail** was not mentioned at all.

This Three Creeks Trail will be constructed along the right-of-way of the old UPRR line. That right of way bounds the parcel currently occupied by Shark Ice and the Municipal Stadium to the south and to the east (including the curve along the southeast of the parcel).

This Trail has been identified in the City's Greenprint (see, e.g., Appendix C, page C14, or the District 7 map). It is an essential cross-town link in a city that is well served by trails in a north-south direction, but which has no trail south of Hwy 237 to link the trails from east to west. It will be essential to the city's mode-share goals, as it will provide a link for pedestrians and bicycles to Tamien Station, and it will link with the Five Wounds Trail that goes past the future 28th Street/Little Portugal BART station. Furthermore, it offers a recreational opportunity in an underserved community. And finally, it is a critical component of any future Loop Trail around downtown, a trail that is now only partially complete, and that is an inspiration for those who love San Jose.

We are concerned about the future of that trail, given the potential for encroachment raised by the MOU that the City will negotiate with Shark Ice. We therefore request that the City commit to preserving the right of way for the Three Creeks Trail in the Memorandum of Understanding that will be negotiated.

Three Creeks Trail will connect three existing river trail systems (Los Gatos Creek, Guadalupe River, and Coyote Creek) and will be a part of the system of trails linking the Ridge Trail to the Bay Trail in the South Bay. Inter-departmental coordination is essential as well as outreach to all constituencies, not just the Sharks. If the city chooses not to include this portion of the Three Creeks Trail through the Sharks Ice property it would effectively end the possibility of this east/west trail connection and a true off-road loop around downtown. However, if the city includes the trail through this property it will show the way for the other landlords along this RR right of way that the trail might be able to skirt their properties as well. This action would accelerate the completion of The Three Creeks Trail.

Mr. Sykes, when will there be a community outreach meeting considering this property? Also, can you help set up a joint meeting with Save Our Trails, Friends of Five Wounds Trail, PRNS, OED, and Planning?

We have noted in the past that sometimes coordination between OED and PRNS has been incomplete. We do not wish to see that happen in this instance. Connecting the three major north/south river trail systems through the city with an east/west trail on the south side of downtown to be the final connection in an approximate marathon length loop trail around downtown is an opportunity not to be missed. We believe that finishing Three Creeks Trail to create a loop trail around the downtown core will be an economic driver itself.

Thank you, Mayor Liccardo, Mr. Sykes, and Councilmember Esparza. We look forward to hearing back from you.

Talking about the future, of good guidelines, public oversight, peace, good democratic practices, and community sustainability, should not have to be, fearful, secretive. or under too much pressure.
