SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF 14th ANNUAL WEST VALLEY SENIOR WALK SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICTS 1 AND 6 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the 14th Annual West Valley Senior Walk on April 26, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the August 27, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The 14th Annual West Valley Senior Walk was held on April 26, 2019 at Westfield Valley Fair Mall and sponsored by Vice Mayor Chappie Jones and Councilmember Dev Davis. This special event included a resource fair that provided beneficial information regarding health and services available in San Jose to the Senior community. The event provided health education resources, breakfast, giveaways, and moderate exercise activities to encourage seniors to live a healthy lifestyle. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Vice Mayor Chappie Jones and Councilmember Dev Davis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council Districts 1 and 6, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
