RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively approve the Northside Night Market scheduled on Saturday, August 24, 2019, as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Retroactively approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the August 27, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Northside Night Market was held on Saturday, August 24, 2019 at Backesto Park and was sponsored by Councilmember Raul Peralez. The Northside Night Market provided an opportunity for community members to come together to enjoy live music, food trucks, free ice cream and family friendly activities. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1).
