SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF THE GUADALUPE RIVER PARK COMMUNITY CLEAN UP SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the Guadalupe River Park Community Clean Up scheduled on Tuesday, July 16, 2019, as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.

2. Retroactively approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.

3. Place the item on the August 27, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Guadalupe River Park Community Clean Up was held on Tuesday, July 16, 2019 at Columbus Park and was sponsored by Councilmember Raul Peralez. The Guadalupe River Park Community Clean Up provided an opportunity for community members to beautify their parks by assisting in the removal of litter throughout Columbus Park and the Guadalupe River Park. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL

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requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 3, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
