RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the Estates Neighborhood Block Party scheduled on Sunday, August 25, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the September 10, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Estates Neighborhood Block Party held on Sunday, August 25, 2019 at Evergreen Park and sponsored by Councilmember Arenas to introduce and share information about opportunities about hosting a neighborhood watch or crime prevention workshop. In addition, the event will help support the development of a neighborhood association. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure
