RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the POW/MIA Flag Raising scheduled on September 20, 2019 as a City Councilsponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.

2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.

3. Place the item on the September 17th Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds. This special event recognizes those who were prisoners of war, and those who are still missing in action. The Flag raising will be honoring all veterans, and the event is free and open to the public.

The display of the POW/MIA flag on September 20th is permitted under Council Policy 2-1, Section C.3 - Flags Displayed in Conjunction with Official Ceremonial Items: "Other flags may be displayed in conjunction with official actions, ceremonial items, or proclamations of the City Council."

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events.
