Analysis

GREEN LIGHT: The Administration can implement this Nominated Idea under its current workplan. Item should be sent to Council to add to Department workplan. Explain how the Idea will be approached.

Story Rd and Jackson Av are both Vision Zero Priority Safety Corridors. DOT has already completed safety assessments for both corridors. Identified enhancements range from low cost (such as signing and striping) to high cost (such as potential signal modification and civil work).

Staff time will be associated with further scoping of high cost measures and the development of cost estimates for a range of improvements at the intersection. This work will inform a mid-year budget proposal for the intersection.

NOTE: If funding were allocated mid-year and involved major changes to the intersection, design work would occur in FY20-21, with construction likely occurring in FY21-22.
