RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the Berryessa Branch Library Mid-Autumn Festival event scheduled on August 26, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.

2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.

3. Place the item on the September 17, 2019 City Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Berryessa Branch Library held a Mid-Autumn Festival on September 7, 2019. This event had arts & crafts, resource tables, and was open to the public. This event was aimed to bring out families to the library and educate them on the Mid-Autumn Festival and its cultural significance. Councilmember Lan Diep donated to the event by purchasing 52 moon cakes for attendees to sample.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Diep will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 4, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed

with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
