- **252** affordable apartments in progress
- **68** persons living with HIV/AIDS received permanent rental assistance

Respond to Homelessness and its Impact

- 🏠 **1,476** homeless people received outreach services
- 🏠 **5,685** outreach contacts made with homeless individuals
- 🏠 **67** homeless individuals participated in job training
- 🏠 **62** households assisted with Tenant Based Rental Assistance
- 🏠 **26** families assisted with homelessness prevention services



Strengthen Neighborhoods – Public Services

Neighborhood Engagement = **516** individuals participated

Senior Services = **207** individuals assisted

Minor Repair Program = **289** households assisted

Enhanced Code Enforcement = **522** violations corrected



Promote Fair Housing Choices

97% of complainants receiving legal services improved their access to housing
