**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF DISABILITY AWARENESS DAY SPONSORED BY
COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL
EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF
MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve Disability Awareness Day scheduled on October 3, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the October 15, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Disability Awareness Day was held on October 3, 2019 at San Jose City Hall and sponsored by Vice Mayor Jones. This special event builds an integrated community by empowering people with differing abilities to overcome barriers through access to resources, education, and employment opportunities while increasing the appreciation of people with differing abilities by highlighting their talents and gifts. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Jones will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the

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event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 1, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.

The Office of the City Clerk will post the item on the City's Website for the October 2, 2019 Rules Committee Agenda and the October 15, 2019 City Council Agenda.
