**SUBJECT: DOWNTOWN PARKING BOARD FY 2018-19 ANNUAL REPORT AND
FY 2019-20 WORKPLAN**

RECOMMENDATION

Accept the Downtown Parking Board (DPB) Annual Report for FY 2018-19 and Workplan for FY 2019-20.

BACKGROUND

San Jose Municipal Code Section 2.08.030.C and Council Policy 0-4, Consolidated Policy Governing Boards and Commissions, Council Policy 0-4, require each board and commission subject to Section 2.08 to submit their annual report of accomplishments and annual workplan of activities to be undertaken, to the designated Council Committee each fiscal year. The Transportation and Environment Committee is the designated Council Committee for the Downtown Parking Board.

At its May 1, 2019 meeting, the DPB preliminarily approved staff's recommended draft workplan and subsequently approved the final workplan and FY 2018-19 Annual Report at its September 4, 2019 meeting.

ANALYSIS

Highlights of the Annual Report include the Boards ongoing focus on review and recommendations related to the Parking Fund financials and Capital Improvement Projects. Additionally the Board oversaw the review of various parking policy items and:

- Approved the Deployment of License Plate Recognition (LPR) technology at the City's eight off-street parking locations and the development of an LPR Use of Data Policy as required by California State Law
- Reviewed downtown parking inventory and discussed future impacts from downtown development
