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What is the Consolidated Plan?

- ▲ Five-year plan required by HUD to spend federal funds
- ▲ Four funding programs
 - Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
 - HOME Investment Partnership (HOME)
 - Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA)
 - Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)
- ▲ Prioritizes certain housing & community development needs set by fair housing study



2015-2020 Consolidated Plan Goals

- ▲ Increasing & Preserving Affordable Housing Opportunities
- ▲ Responding to Homelessness & Its Impacts on the Community
- ▲ Strengthening Neighborhoods
- ▲ Promoting Fair Housing

- 🏠 Community survey/pop-up events
- 🏠 Targeted feedback from stakeholders
- 🏠 Feedback through other public processes
- 🏠 HUD-required outreach

 - Housing & Community Development Commission hearing
 - Two City Council hearings
