Staff is already conducting a review of residential zoning districts as part of the Zoning/General Plan Conformance project, which will result in amendments to the Zoning Ordinance to better align its development standards with the types of residential and mixed development called for in the Envision San Jose 2040 General Plan. Amendments to single family zoning districts to discourage modifications of single family homes for use as individual room rentals can be incorporated into this Zoning Ordinance amendment that is planned for Council consideration in the late spring/early summer 2020.
