


Project Location and Overview





- Replace 8 clarifier mechanisms
- Rehabilitate up to 8 return activated sludge (RAS) pipelines with cured-in-place-pipe (CIPP) lining
- Repair concrete clarifier walls and slabs, replace drain valves and RAS valves, rehabilitate groundwater pressure relief valves, and replace electrical and instrumentation and control equipment for 16 clarifiers
- Project will improve operational reliability and efficiency of the secondary treatment process to ensure continued regulatory compliance at the RWF


Replacement of 8 Clarifier Mechanisms



- Bids Ranged from \$26,184,000 to \$37,779,000

- Bid: \$26,184,000


Construction Schedule

Project Cost Summary



Recommendation

- 1. Award the construction contract for Nitrification Clarifier Rehabilitation Project Phase 1 Project to the low bidder, C. Overaa & Co., in the amount of \$26,184,000 and approve a 20% contingency in the amount of \$5,237,000.
- 2. Authorize the Director of Public Works to negotiate and execute one or more change orders in excess of \$100,000 for the duration of the project, not to exceed the total contingency amount approved for the project.
