

# MINUTES OF THE JOINT MEETING OF THE RULES AND OPEN GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE AND COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

The Joint Meeting of the Rules and Open Government Committee and Committee of the Whole of the City of San José convened in Regular Session at 2:00 p.m. in Council Chambers.

# 2. Single Family Home Modifications. (Jimenez & Davis)

<u>Documents Filed</u>: (1) Joint memorandum from Councilmember Sergio Jimenez and Councilmember Dev Davis, dated October 10, 2019, recommending direction regarding proposed revisions to the Zoning Ordinance. (2) Early Consideration Response Form from Councilmember Sergio Jimenez and Councilmember Dev Davis regarding Single Family Home Modifications.

<u>Public Comments</u>: A member of the public addressed increased violence in downtown and the need for intervention.

Councilmember Sergio Jimenez spoke on consideration of this item, and Councilmember Dev Davis offered comments, indicating that extreme modifications happening under current rules without any transparency. Planning Supervisor, Martina Davis, offered clarification regarding current rules regarding single family home modifications.

Discussion followed with recommendations that revisions be considered, with direction to staff to return to Council with proposed revisions to the Zoning Ordinance that would thoroughly vet single family home modifications that are clearly designed to facilitate an excessive number of individual room rentals.

Staff additionally agreed to return with a definition of what 'excessive' is, returning to Council for agreement on an objective standard.

<u>Action</u>: Upon motion by Councilmember Dev Davis, seconded by Councilmember Sylvia Arenas and carried unanimously, the joint memorandum from Councilmember Sergio Jimenez and Councilmember Dev Davis, dated October, 2019, was accepted with modifications that staff return to Council with proposed revisions to the Zoning Ordinance that would thoroughly vet single family home modifications that are clearly designed to facilitate an excessive number of individual room rentals. (5-0.)
