Ratification and Termination or Extension of Proclamation of Local Emergency Due to Predicted High Fire Risk Conditions and Expected Public Safety Power Shutoff.

Recommendation:

(a) Adopt a resolution ratifying and terminating or extending the Director of Emergency Services' Proclamation of October 26, 2019 of the existence of a local emergency resulting from predicted high wildfire risk conditions and PG&E's notice that it would execute a Public Safety Power Shutoff affecting portions of the City of San José.

(b) Receive staff's update on the status of the Public Safety Power Shutoff, its impact on the City of San José, and recovery efforts.

CEQA: Statutory Exempt, Section 15269, Emergency Projects Undertaken for specific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency. (City Manager)

Documents filed: (1) Memorandum from City Manager, designee as EOC Director, and Emergency Services Director, Kip Harkness, dated October 26, 2019. (2) Proclamation of Local Emergency, dated October 26, 2019. (3) Staff presentation, entitled, "PG&E Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) Event Update". (4) A Resolution of the Council of the City of San Jose.

City Manager's Office Chief of Staff Lee Wilcox, and City Manager's Office of Emergency Management Director, Raymond Riordan gave a presentation and responded to questions.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Pam Foley to move approval, seconded by Councilmember Maya Esparza, and carried unanimously, staff report was accepted as recommended, and Resolution No. 79290, terminating the local emergency proclamation, was adopted.
