RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively approve the D6 Faith Leaders Luncheon held on September 6, 2018 and the D6 Faith Leaders Breakfast held on October 31, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Events and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the November 19, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The D6 Faith Leaders Luncheon was held on September 6, 2018 and the D6 Faith Leaders Breakfast was held on October 31, 2019. Both events were sponsored by Councilmember Dev Davis. These non-denominational community events united District 6 faith community leaders to start new relationships, and thanked their organizations for their service to the City of San Jose. The events were free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure

requirements, Councilmember Dev Davis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
