My name is Michelle O'Hara and I am the Principal of Primary Plus Elementary School on Amber Drive. I have been informed that there is a plan in place to add a 5G Cell Tower on the light pole in front of our school.

There was no notification to Primary Plus that this was going to take place. I am aware that there is a court order for the FCC to comply with an environmental review before any installation. I am also aware that this environmental review did not happen prior to the City of San Jose signing the contracts.

It is at this time that I request the installation be stopped and put on hold until the FCC complies with an environmental review. I am also requesting that the City of San Jose make an ordinance for 5G small cells to be installed no less than 1000 FEET FROM SCHOOLS.

I have been informed that Verizon will install a 5G small cell antenna in front of my house on _____, San Jose, CA 95117 - project CA_SJ_SANJOSE_WEST_107 (Location # 517861). I am informing you and your administration that I strongly oppose to the installation of Verizon small cell antenna next to my house. As soon as I got the notification, and within 20 days, I tried to contact the CBR Group (the contractor choose by Verizon to do the 5G small cells installations). In my emails to CBR Group, I told them I strongly oppose to the 5G small cell installation in front of my home. At the beginning, CBR responded to my emails, and provided some measurements, that are not accurate. I can proof it with the current correct measurements from the field.

I have also send an email to San Jose City representative (Crawford, Liam) with detailed measurements that proves the metrics provided by CBR Group for their Permit approval are not accurate. The city representative received my email and redirected me to CBR group. If this is the way City of San Jose is responding on this kind of situations, this should be reviewed and changed. When I approached CBR group about inaccurate measurements they stopped responding to my emails.

This is a direct violation of City of San Jose Permit processing guidance section 4e, for 5G small cells installation. According to this section, CBR is required to notify the City about any unresolved issues.

I wanted to bring this situation to your attention, as we are not alone, but from what I learn this is the way CBR Group is misleading the people of San Jose, as well as the San Jose City, in order to receive the approval for their installations. Based on the behavior of CBR group and their refusal to communicate with us about accuracy of measurements I feel it is crucial to inform the City of San Jose about such behavior and submit formal request for a complete stop of antenna installation near my house.

Please ask your representative to apply San Jose City "municipal code" rules to the small cells installations.

I am aware that there is a court order for the FCC to comply with an environmental review before installations, and so I request that this installation be stopped and put on hold until the FCC complies with an environmental review.

In view of unresolved technical and health issues, I request that the city of San Jose adopt an ordinance requiring set-backs at least 300 feet from homes and 1000 feet from schools of small cell 5G equipment, and a minimum distance of 1500 feet between 5G small cell towers.

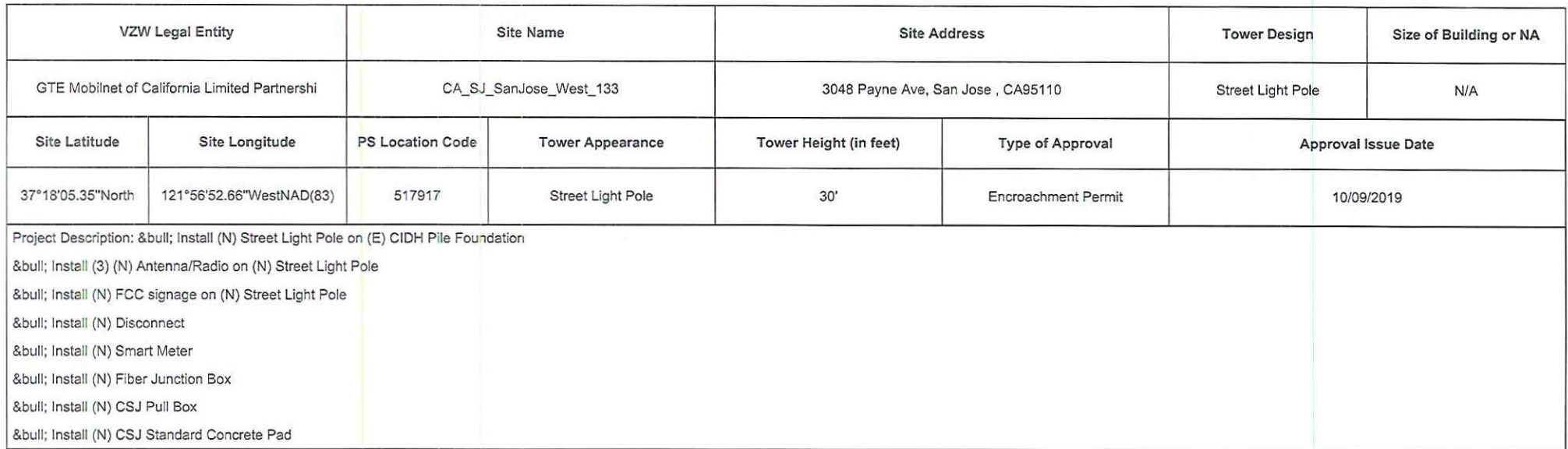

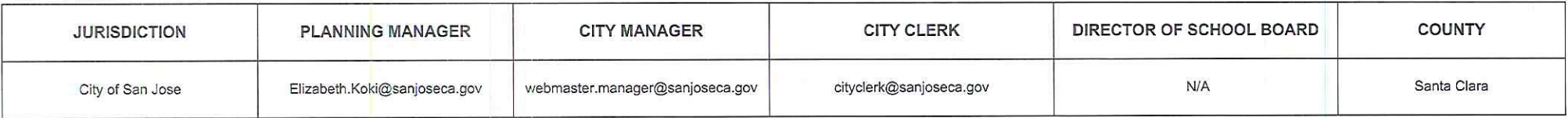

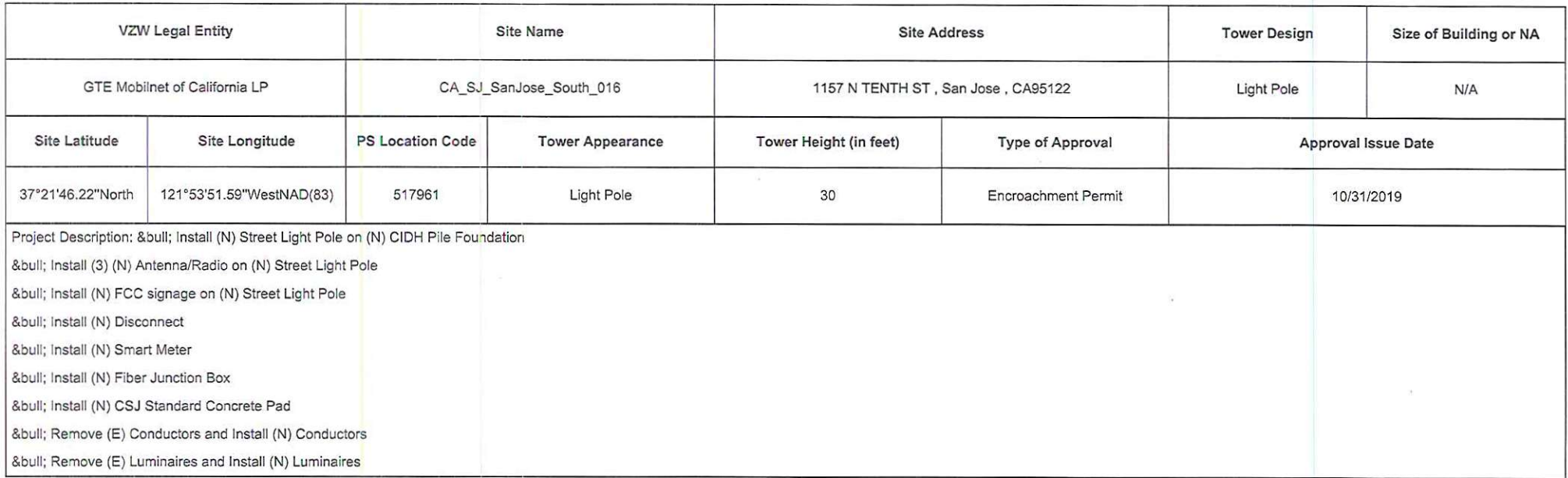

This isn't news anymore that we now have homeless encampments in pretty much every corner of the city of San Jose. While I appreciate the steps put forward by the city council to have mobile sanitation centers and warming centers for the homeless, we don't see any steps taken to actually reduce the number of homeless on our streets.

The blight and encampments along Monterey road between Senter Rd and Skyway Dr is truly an eyesore and every time we try to report this to the city, we get a response saying that the area belong to the UPRR and city does not have access. However, what would you say to the tents now appearing on Branham lane just outside the Deer Run 2 community at Frontier Village. Is that UPRR property as well?

I saw one tent appear at the intersection at Monterey-Branham a few weeks ago, but since last week, we have 6 to 7 tents at the same location now and at least 10-12 bicycles at that spot. I am a resident of the Deer Run 2 community and I don't see how we can ignore this. It's a shame that we have to keep bringing up this issue ever so often.

I would like answers to the following questions:

1. Is it legal to camp on city owned land? If not, what steps will be taken to remove the illegal campsites?
2. The number of tents on Branham has gone up from 1 to 7. What are you doing to stop more tents from coming up ?
3. The encampments at that location has also resulted in trash being strewn at that very spot. When can we expect that to be cleaned up?

Dear Mayor Liccardo, Vice Mayor Jones, and Councilmembers Jimenez, Peralez, Diep, Carrasco, Davis, Esparza, Arenas, Foley, Khamis:

We are excited to share that LifeMoves is receiving \$1M in grant funding from Google.org to expand shelter capacity by 20% at two homeless shelters in San Jose, Villa and Georgia Travis House that serve families, women and children. Work is scheduled for completion in May 2020 and will allow for an additional 100 people to be given a bed per year. With this grant, LifeMoves will qualify for matching funding from Santa Clara County's Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP). This grant is from Google.org's \$50M commitment to supporting solutions to homelessness that was announced along with Google's \$1B housing announcement in June.
