SUBJECT: UPDATES TO THE AUGUST - DECEMBER 2019 NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES & EDUCATION COMMITTEE WORKPLAN

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the following change to the August - December 2019 Neighborhood Services & Education Committee Workplan to drop the following item from December 12, 2019 and direct the Administration to add the item to a Council Study Session in early 2020:

BeautifySJ Annual Report and Update on Council Policy Priority #25 (Private Property Graffiti Abatement Ordinance). (Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services/Planning, Building and Code Enforcement)

Purpose: Provide a report on the City's BeautifySJ programming, including Anti-Graffiti and Anti-Litter programming, the implementation of the Blight Busters program; and an update on Council Policy Priority #25 (Private Property Graffiti Abatement Ordinance).

BACKGROUND

Staff requests dropping the BeautifySJ Annual Report and Update on Council Policy Priority #25 (Private Property Graffiti Abatement Ordinance) from the Neighborhood Services & Education Committee's December 12, 2019 agenda. This comprehensive staff report addresses citywide blight and the intersection of homelessness and will not be completed until after January 2020. The purpose of the BeautifySJ Annual Report is to provide an update on services and activities associated with the BeautifySJ Initiative. Updates will include current metrics on blight reduction programs, inter-departmental strategies, coordinated citywide efforts, and challenges.

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Adding the BeautifySJ Annual Report to a Council Study Session will allow for a more robust discussion of blight, its impact to the community, proposed strategies, resource needs and current challenges.
