A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ACCEPTING THE SPENDING PLAN FOR THE INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE INVITED AWARDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$558,585, AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING ONLINE CERTIFICATIONS AT TIME OF REIMBURSEMENT REQUEST, WITHOUT FURTHER CITY COUNCIL ACTION

WHEREAS, in 1998, the U.S. Department of Justice's Office of Juvenile Justice Delinquency and Prevention ("OJJDP") created the Internet Crimes Against Children ("ICAC") Task Force Program in response to increasing numbers of child sexual abuse images available on the internet and online activities by predators seeking unsupervised contact with children; and

WHEREAS, the City of San José's ("City") Police Department recognized the need to protect children in the community from this fast-growing trend and applied for and was awarded its first ICAC grant in February 2003, and since that time, the Police Department has applied for and received several ICAC continuation grants that have provided funding for overtime, equipment, vehicles for investigations, and training of investigators for the ICAC program; and

**WHEREAS**, in August 2019, the OJJDP invited the Police Department to apply for the fiscal year 2019-2020 ICAC grant and the application was accepted and approved in the amount of \$558,585; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to accept the spending plan for the ICAC grant, which is discussed in the memorandum to the City Council from Edgardo Garcia, Chief of Police, and execute the grant agreement;
