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Administrative Citations for Compliance, Not Revenue






Limits rent increases for all apartments built before 1979



Tenant Protection Ordinance

Requires just cause for notice of termination for all apartments



Ellis Act Ordinance

Intent to demolish;
Requires noticing and/or relocation benefits for eligible apartments





Fine Amount Determination

- Type and severity of violation
- Deterrence against future violations
- Violations affecting entire complex or individual households
- Escalation of fines






Administrative Citation Process

Step 1	Step 2 Citation Issued	Step 3 Request Hearing	Step 4 Administrative Citation Hearing
NON-CURABLE Attend a Compliance Class (except for Ellis Act Ordinance violations) OR	Rent Stabilization Program staff will issue a citation for violators	Request for hearing, if owner disputes citation Payment required unless hardship approved	Administrative citation hearing would determine the final outcome of the violation and correlating fines
CURABLE Non-compliance letters Occurrence first time violations can be resolved during tenancy

Continue education and outreach to owners






Recommendation
