RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the Dumpster Day event scheduled on December 14, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the December 10, 2019 City Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Dumpster Day event will be held on December 14, 2019 at Laneview Elementary and sponsored by Councilmember Lan Diep. There will be 7 dumpsters available for residents to dispose their household items as well as supplies for volunteers. This special event was aimed at stemming illegal dumping and informing residents about free junk pickup. Several volunteers participated in the event. The event was free and open to residents who registered ahead of time.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Diep will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 4, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
