

SUBJECT: ACTIONS RELATED TO THE PURCHASE ORDER FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROLLERS

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to:

1. Execute a Purchase Order with Econolite (Anaheim, CA) for the purchase of Traffic Signal Controllers, including hardware, software, and maintenance for the twelve-month period, starting on or about December 18, 2019 and ending on or about December 17, 2020, with maximum compensation not to exceed \$800,000; and
2. Exercise up to four additional one-year options to extend the term of the purchase order after the initial term with the last option year ending on or about December 17, 2024, to purchase additional controllers and provide ongoing maintenance and support, subject to the appropriation of funds.

Desired Outcome: To ensure traffic signals are working in optimal condition so that traffic and pedestrians move as efficiently and safely as possible through intersections.

BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation seeks to purchase traffic signal controllers to upgrade existing aging traffic signal controllers. Signal controllers control vehicle and pedestrian movements via traffic signals. The new traffic signal equipment will allow safer, more reliable signal operations that will improve movement of traffic and people throughout the City.

A competitive Request for Bid (RFB) was facilitated by the Finance Department to procure these controllers. Three bids were submitted and no protests were received. Two bidders applied and qualified for the local business preference, but award of the preference was not determinative in the recommended award. Staff recommends award to Econolite as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder pursuant to the bidding procedures of the San Jose Municipal Code, Section 4.12.310B.

Climate Smart San Jose: The recommendation in this memo aligns with one or more Climate Smart San José energy, water, or mobility goals.

Commission Recommendation/Input: There is no commission recommendation or input associated with this action.

This council item is consistent with the City's 2019-2020 Adopted Budget City Areas Delivery Framework: "To provide the community with safe, secure, and efficient surface and air transportation systems that support San Jose's livability and economic vitality."
