

FirstNet Update

- March 30, 2017, AT&T selected by FirstNet
- CalOES negotiated improvements to the California Plan
- December 28, 2017, California Opted in
- March 30, 2018, AT&T FirstNet Core online
- October 19, 2019, State/FirstNet Procurement Agreement
- June 25, 2019, Contract executed with FirstNet for citywide deployment
- October 18, 2019, FirstNet Phase 1 Charter signed
- November 21, 2019, initial pilot phone deployment
- Band 14 sites: 73 in San José with 174 sites Countywide
