



Investment in Curtner Studios

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Progress to Date – Supportive Housing

- County of Santa Clara has invested \$256,780,000 in 22 developments in six cities in 2,272 affordable apartments − 1,124 are supportive housing
- ▲ City of San Jose has invested \$83,992,487 in 14 developments in 1,559 affordable apartments 700 are supportive housing





Property History

- ◆ Developed in 1993 with City financing to provide weeknight housing for commuters from Los Banos, Hollister, Tracy, etc.
 - 144 units rent-restricted
- Property sold to First Community Housing in 2007 with additional
 City financing
 - All 179 units rent-restricted
 - 27 units reserved for people with mental health issues
- In 2015, FCH brought in Abode to provide supportive services, including support for 40 formerly homeless residents





Current Proposal

- Affordability restriction extended by an additional 55 yrs
- Building will become 100% supportive housing with project-based vouchers for all units
- Space will be added for case management and common areas
