- Hate Crime vs. Hate-Motivated Incident



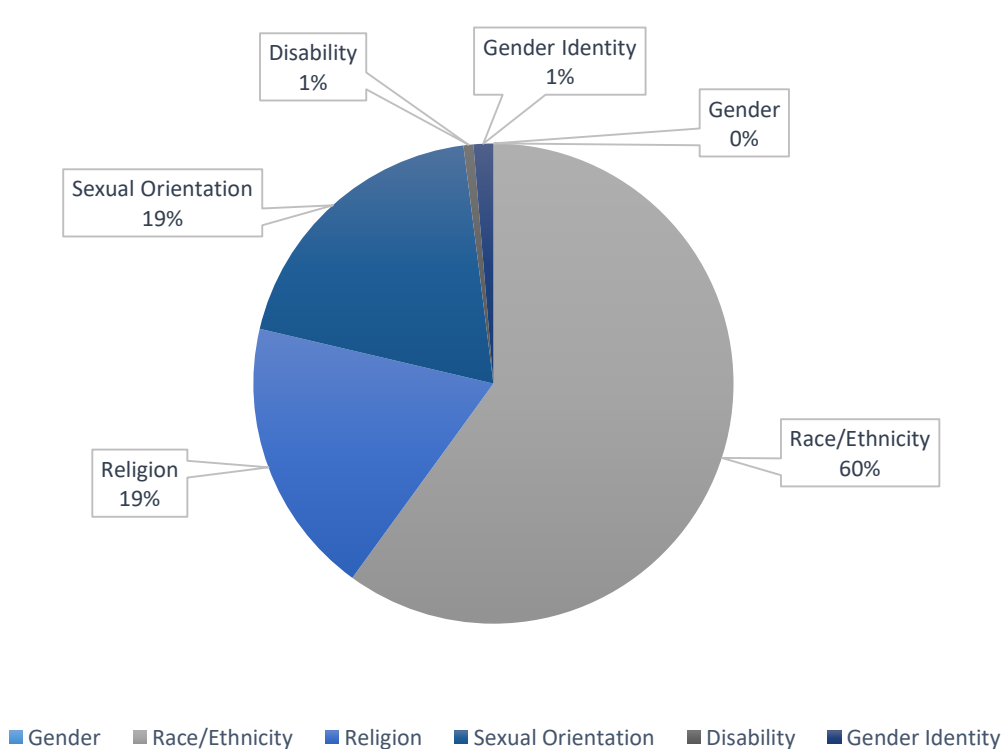

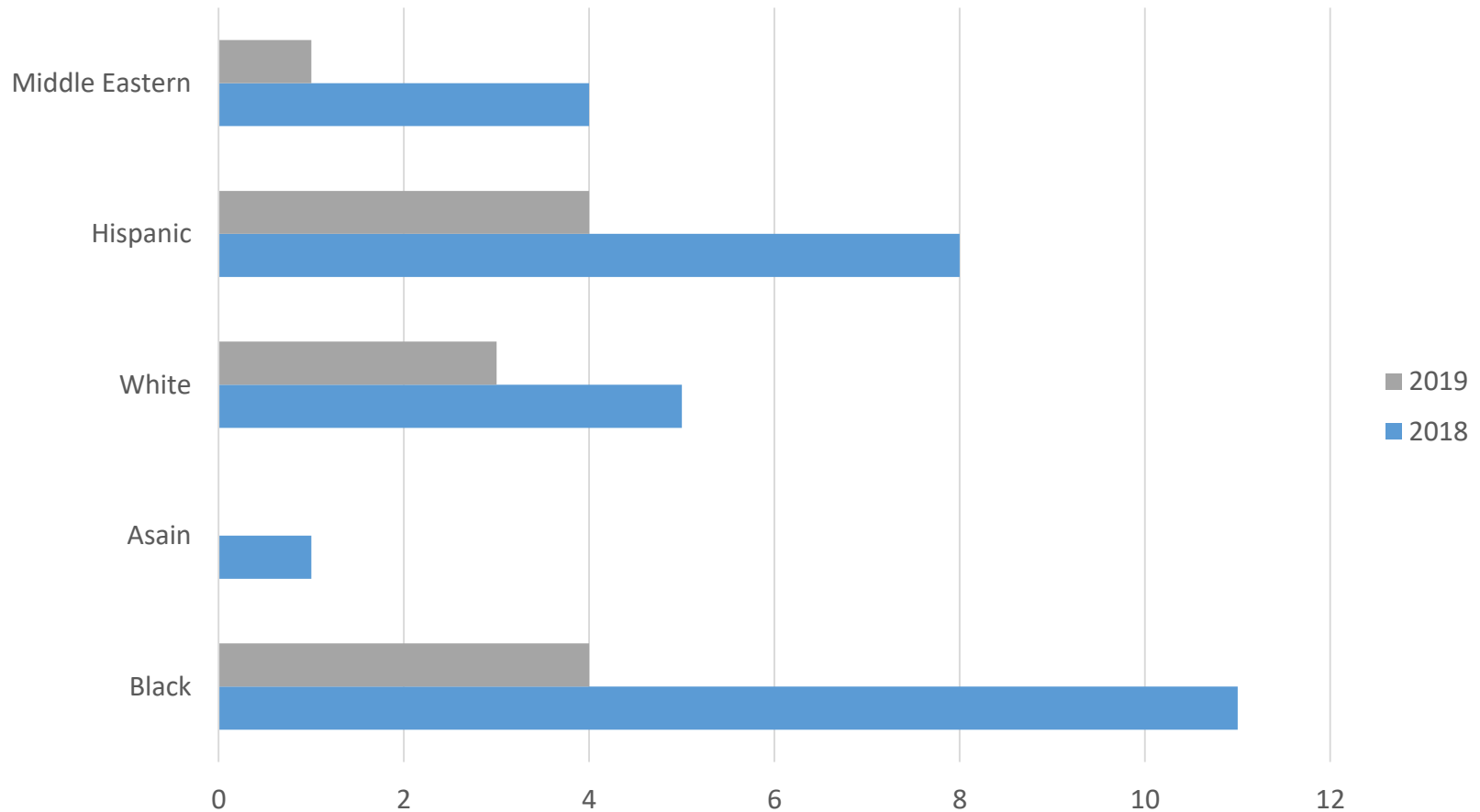

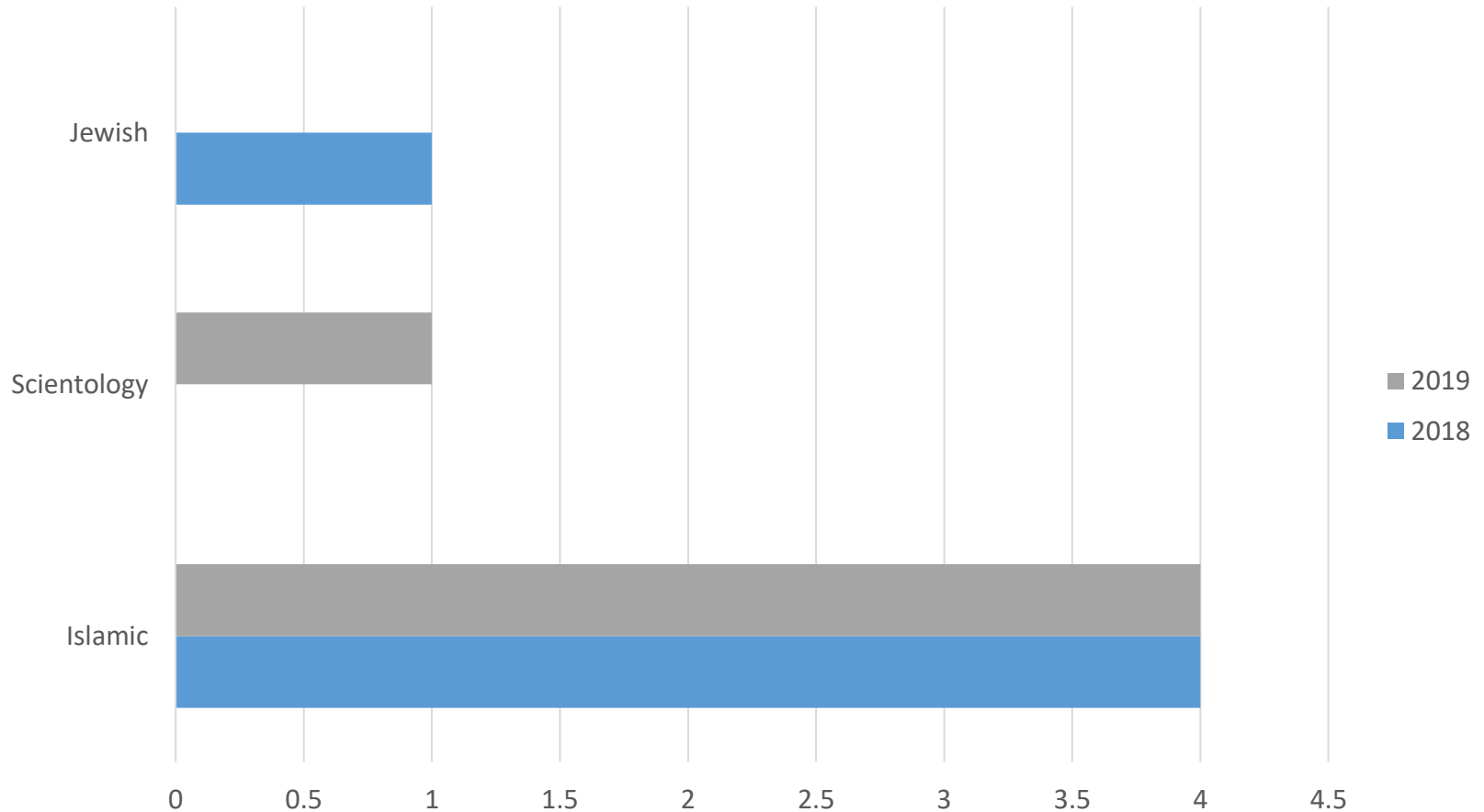

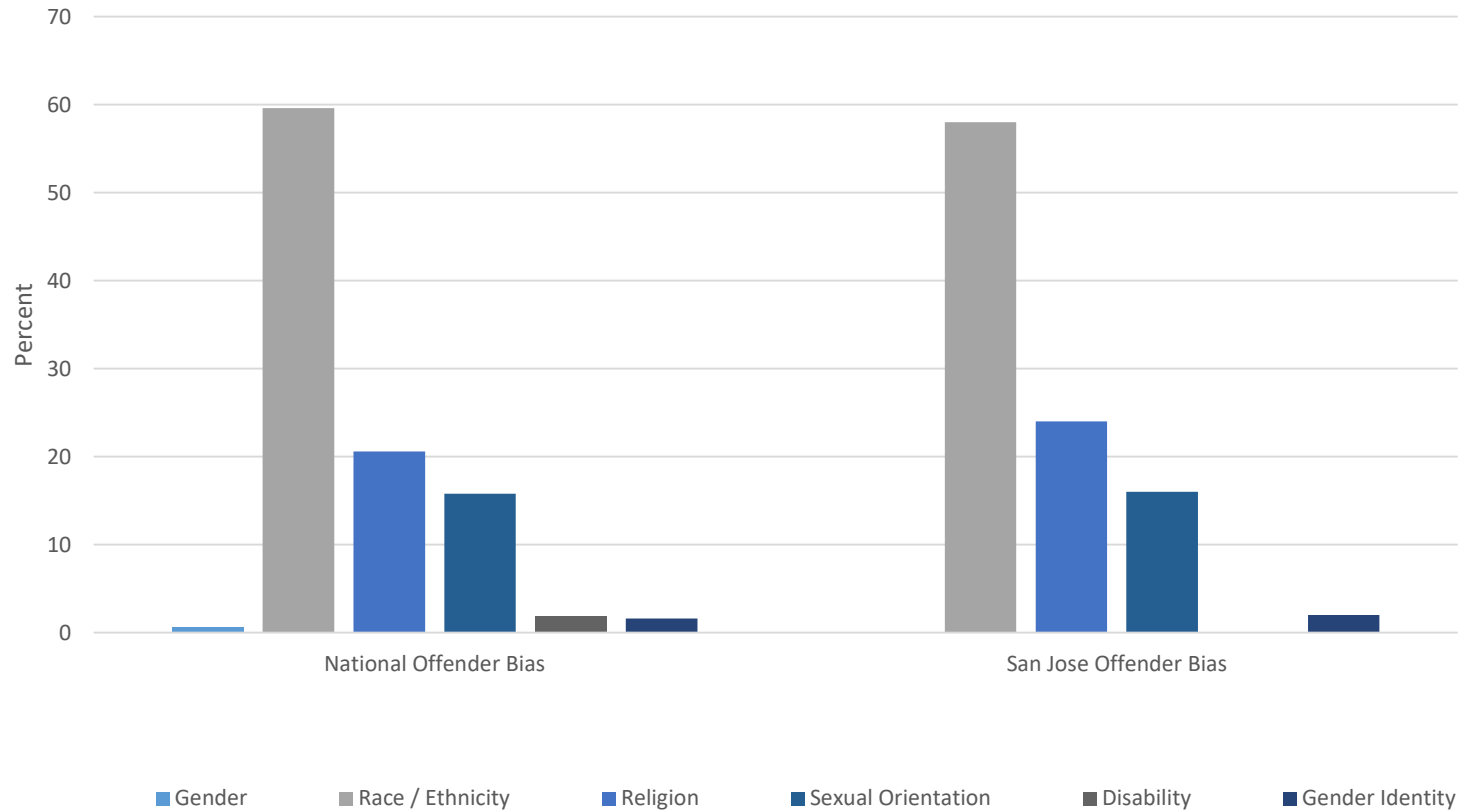
# Race/Ethnicity Offender Bias Breakdown, 2018-2019

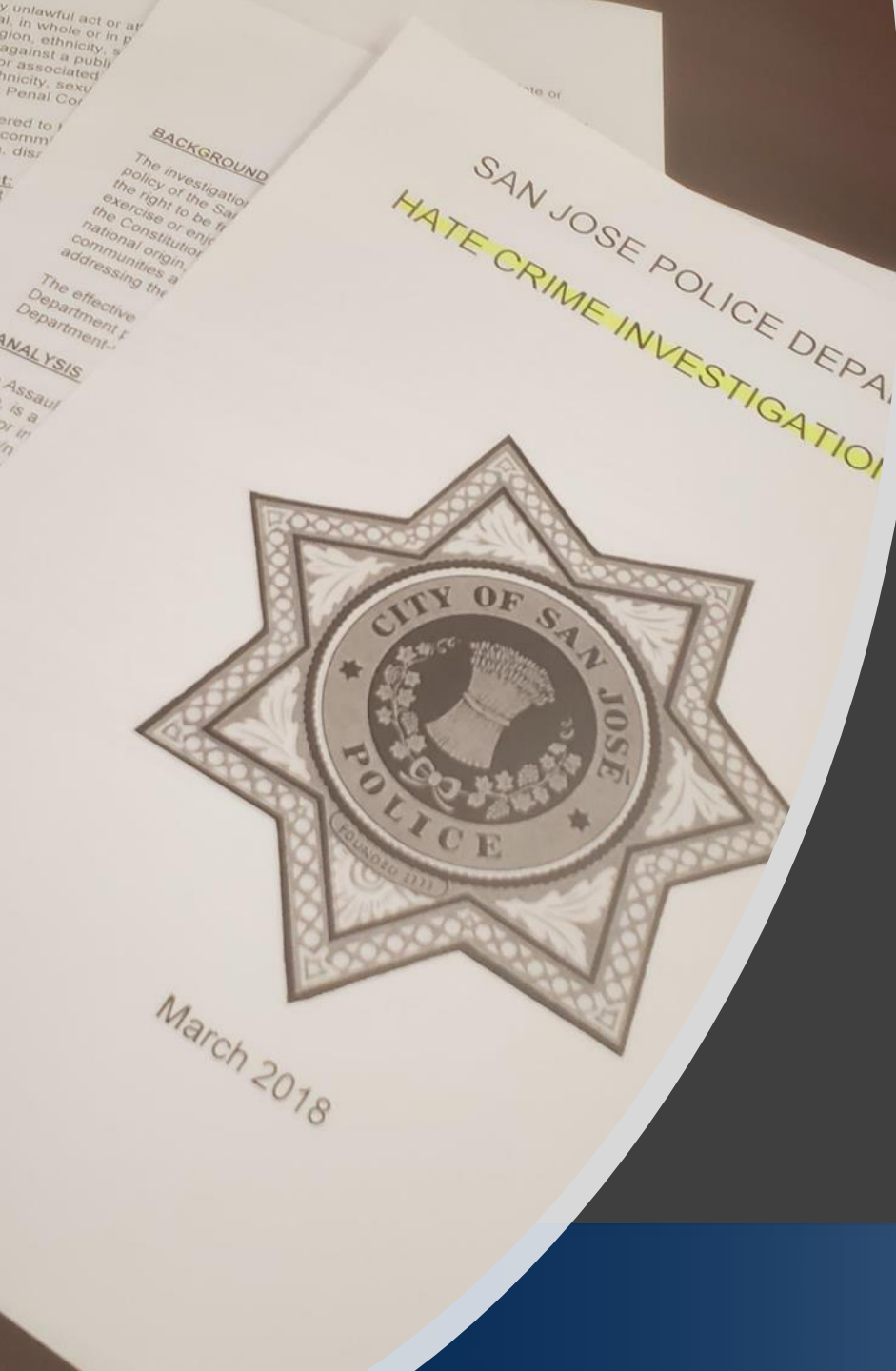
