SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF VIETNAMESE LUNAR NEW YEAR-TET FESTIVAL COMMUNITY EVENT SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

## RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively approve Vietnamese Lunar New Year Tet-Festival scheduled on Friday. January 24, 2020 through Sunday January 26, 2020 and January 31, 2020 through Sunday. February 2, 2020 at Eastridge Mall as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the Tuesday, February 25, 2020 Council Agenda for action.

#### BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Vietnamese Lunar New Year Tet-Festival was held on two consecutive weekends on Friday, January 24, 2020 through Sunday January 26, 2020 and January 31, 2020 through Sunday, February 2, 2020 at Eastridge Mall in San Jose and sponsored by Councilmember Arenas. This special event brought residents together to celebrate Lunar New Year with free family-friendly activities, including live entertainment, carnival games, rides and more. The event was free and open to the public.

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#### **ANALYSIS**

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Arenas will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 8, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
