Analysis

The proposed idea is recommended to be Yellow Light since the current work is not part of the existing work plan for the required Departments. Exploring procurement of a plastic purification and recycling plant on the vacant lands adjacent to the Regional Wastewater Facility (RWF) would be a significant undertaking and would necessitate exploring updates to the Master Plan for the RWF and understanding the potential business and legal issues related to the current contracts for material collection.

There was significant community and stakeholder engagement as part of the prior Master Plan process and it anticipated that further and significant outreach would be needed as a part of the process to explore opportunities of this nature. As part of this process staff would also need to consider General Plan land use changes that would facilitate a plastic purification and recycling plant. While CEQA would not be required prior to Council Action, an environmental analysis should be done as part of the exploratory process to understand if environmental impacts and mitigation could ultimately affect the feasibility of a project and/or understand the best location for the plant from and an environmental perspective. In addition to these process steps, staff would need to follow the mandated surplus sales process required by State law, and would likely need to delay or offset other Policy priorities to accommodate the significant workload.
