**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE GRANTING  
A COMMERCIAL SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLES  
COLLECTION FRANCHISE TO GARDEN OF EDEN  
LANDSCAPES, INC. DBA GROUND FORCE  
ENTERPRISES**

**WHEREAS**, Garden of Eden Landscapes, Inc., a California corporation doing business as Ground Force Enterprises (“Ground Force Enterprises”), has submitted an application to the City of San José for a Commercial Solid Waste and Recyclables Collection Franchise; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 25, 2020, the City Council held a public hearing to consider said application and to hear all persons desiring to be heard in favor of or in opposition to the granting of a Commercial Solid Waste and Recyclables Collection Franchise to Ground Force Enterprises; and

**WHEREAS**, having considered all oral and documentary evidence presented on the matter of granting such franchise, the City Council has determined that the grant of such franchise to Ground Force Enterprises is in the public interest;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby grants a Commercial Solid Waste and Recyclables Collection Franchise to Ground Force Enterprises, pursuant to which Ground Force Enterprises is authorized to engage in the business of collecting, transporting and disposing of Residential Clean-Out Material and Construction and Demolition Debris (“C&D Debris”) kept, accumulated or produced in the City of San José and to use the public streets and rights of way for such purpose.
