RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

State of the District 2020 was held on January 29, 2020 at Willow Glen Community and Senior Center, and was sponsored by Councilmember Dev Davis. This special event gathered residents of District 6 to discuss goals for the year and helped them connect with city departments. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Retroactive approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Dev Davis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 6, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to

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proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
