



Fundamentals of VTA's new transit service plan

- Intensive community outreach (10,000+ points of input)
- Transit network built on a core Frequent Network of bus + rail
- More residents and jobs near the Frequent Network
- New transit connections to BART
- Improved weekend service
- Less service in low-ridership areas and more service in high-ridership areas






Route-by-Route Productivity (Weekday Boardings per Hour)
