**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF HOFFMAN VIA MONTE BEAUTIFICATION DAY
SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 10 AS A CITY COUNCIL
SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT
DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the Hoffman Via Monte Beautification Day, scheduled March 28, 2020, as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the March 24, 2020 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

Project Hope and various neighborhood associations surrounding Hoffman Via Monte are working with the District 10 Council office, to plan a neighborhood beautification day on March 28, 2020. Volunteers from the neighborhood associations will be working to help residents dispose and recycle their trash. In addition, the District 10 office will provide dumpsters, taking advantage of the \$18,000 budgeted in the FY 2019-2020 Operating Budget for community cleanups and dumpster days throughout District 10. In light of the COVID-19 situation, the date of this event is subject to change. Approval of this memo will apply to the rescheduled date, if applicable.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Johnny Khamis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on

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their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 10, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
