A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY HOMELESSNESS FUNDING GRANT FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,919,821, AND NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE RELATED DOCUMENTS WITHOUT FURTHER CITY COUNCIL ACTION TO ACCEPT THESE GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, as described in previous reports to the City Council, the City's Emergency Operations Center has prioritized strategies and actions through a roadmap to effectively respond to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, the Governor signed SB89 which provides funding to protect the health and safety of the homeless population during the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, the City of San Jose was notified that it was awarded \$3,919,820.88 from State SB89 funds. These funds are specifically intended for prevention and containment measures at shelters serving the homeless population; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to authorize the Manager or designee to accept the COVID-19 Emergency Homelessness Funding grant from the State of California in the amount of \$3,919,821 and negotiate and execute related documents without further City Council action to accept these grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The City Manager or designee, is hereby authorized to accept the COVID-19 Emergency Homelessness Funding grant from the State of California in the amount of

\$3,919,821, and negotiate and execute related documents without further City Council action to accept these grant funds, as set forth in Memorandum from Budget Department submitted for the April 7, 2020 meeting.
