SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS MONTH SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve Sexual Assault Awareness Month to be recognized by the City Council on Tuesday, April 28, 2020 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the Tuesday, April 28, 2020 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

In lieu of a City Proclamation, Sexual Assault Awareness Month will be recognized by the City Council on Tuesday, April 28, 2020 and sponsored by Councilmember Arenas. The goal of Sexual Assault Awareness Month is to raise public awareness to end sexual harassment, assault, and abuse and educate communities on how to prevent it. This year, Sexual Assault Awareness Month is celebrating the 19th anniversary with the theme "I Ask" to share the importance of consent.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Arenas will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 8, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
