SUBJECT: DECLARATION AND DATE: March 23, 2020

RECORDING A STATEMENT OF THE RESULTS OF THE

MARCH 3, 2020 PRIMARY MUNICIPAL ELECTION

AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution declaring and recording a statement of the results of the March 3, 2020 Primary Municipal Election and Special Municipal Election per Elections Code Sections 10263, 10264, and 15400.

OUTCOME

The resolution will declare the results of the election, as certified by the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters, and record a statement of:

- The election of Sergio Jimenez to the Office of Councilmember District 2, Sylvia Arenas to the Office of Councilmember District 8, and Matt Mahan to the Office of Councilmember District 10;
- That Measure E, the City of San José's Real Property Transfer Tax, passed by majority vote; and
- The candidates who will proceed to the Run-off Election on November 3, 2020, having received the greatest number of votes in the Primary Election but not a majority of all votes case for such office, are:
 - o Office of Councilmember—District 3: Lan Diep and David Cohen
 - Office of Councilmember—District 6: Dev Davis and Jake Tonkel

BACKGROUND

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 79267 on October 22, 2019 calling for a Primary Municipal Election on March 3, 2020 and a Run-Off Election, if necessary, on November 3, 2020 to elect one person each for the Office of Councilmember for Council Districts 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10 for full four-year terms. The Resolution also requested that the County of Santa Clara Board of Supervisors consolidate the City's elections with the Statewide Primary and Statewide General Elections.

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In addition, on December 3, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 79325, calling for a Special Municipal Election to be held on March 3, 2020 to place a measure on the ballot to amend Title 4 of the San Jose Municipal Code to add Chapter 4.59 related to a new real property transfer tax.

All Municipal Elections were consolidated with the County of Santa Clara and held in accordance with established procedures governing the conduct of elections. Under the Elections Code, the County Registrar of Voters has thirty days to certify the results of an election. The election was conducted on March 3, 2020 so the results should be certified by April 2, 2020. As of the posting of this memorandum, the City Clerk has not received the official Certificate of Election Results, Official Results, and Statement of Votes for all the contests held in the City of San José. Once the Clerk's office receives the Certificate of Election Results, a supplemental memorandum will be submitted and a complete Statement of Votes and Official Final Results will be retained on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

ANALYSIS

According to the County Registrar of Voters website, 99% of all ballots submitted for the March 3, 2020 have been counted as of March 23, 2020. The Registrar of Voter's preliminary results as of this date are as follows:
