

MINUTES OF THE JOINT MEETING OF THE RULES AND OPEN GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE AND COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 8, 2020

Consistent with the California Governor's Executive Order No. N-29-20, Resolution No. 79450 from the City of San José and the Santa Clara County Health Officer's March 16, 2020 Shelter in Place Order, the City Council meeting was not physically open to the public. Public comments were accepted via eComment, email, by phone/Webinar or online.

The Council meeting was teleconferenced from remote locations and convened following a Special Meeting of the City Council at 6:20 p.m.

Assistant City Attorney Ed Moran offered the City Manager's recommendations to change the wording for 8.x, replacing the phrase 'task force', and Mayor Sam Liccardo recommended inclusion of the wording "discuss a convening of stakeholders representing landlords and tenants".

<u>Public Comments</u>: Blair Beekman referenced the San Francisco City Council ordinance as a useful reference point.

<u>Action:</u> Upon motion by Vice Mayor Chappie Jones, seconded by Councilmember Dev Davis, and carried unanimously, the Committee accepted the April 14, 2020 Final Agenda, including two Sunshine waivers for Consent Items, rephrasing of portions of Item 8.x: Extension of the Residential Eviction Moratorium and Consideration of a Rent Freeze and Establish a Task Force to Explore Solutions for the Rental Community Impacted by COVID-19, and including cancellation of the evening session. (5-0.)
