

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE  
AMENDING CHAPTER 4.80 OF TITLE 4 OF THE SAN  
JOSE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD A NEW PART  
RELATED TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE  
CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions and requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, together with related State CEQA Guidelines and Title 21 of the San José Municipal Code (collectively, "CEQA"), the Director of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement has determined that the provisions of this Ordinance do not constitute a project, under File No. PP17-010 (City Organizational & Administrative Activities resulting in no changes to the physical environment) and File No. PP17-004 (Government funding mechanism or fiscal activity with no commitment to a specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of San José is the decision-making body for this Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council has reviewed and considered the "not a project" determination under CEQA prior to taking any approval actions on this Ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

**SECTION 1.** A new Part is added to Chapter 4.80 of Title 4 of the San José Municipal Code, to be numbered, entitled and to read as follows:

**Part 71**  
**Coronavirus Relief Fund**

**4.80.4370 Coronavirus Relief Fund Established**

There is hereby created and established the “Coronavirus Relief Fund.”

**4.80.4380 Source of Monies**

The source of monies budgeted and accounted for in the Coronavirus Relief Fund shall be monies received pursuant to section 601(a) of the Social Security Act, as added by section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, as may be amended, which is referred to in this Ordinance as the CARES Act.

**4.80.4390 Expenditures**

Monies in the Coronavirus Relief Fund shall be expended as authorized by the City Council for use in accordance with the CARES Act and guidelines promulgated by the federal government.

**4.80.4400 Interest**

Interest which accrues from monies in the Coronavirus Relief Fund shall be credited to this Fund.

**SECTION 2.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect retroactive to May 5, 2020.
