An hourly rate shall be charged for all services, unless the charge for the service is already included in the permit fee, as specified in this Resolution. The hourly rate for Development Related services shall be \$124.50 for Plan Check and \$140.00 for Inspection per half hour or fraction thereof and the rate for Non-Development Related services, except Records services, shall be \$108.00 for each half hour or fraction thereof.

Charges for inspections and plan reviews performed during normal duty hours; i.e. between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, exclusive of City holidays, are included in all permit fees. If a requester fails to cancel a requested inspection at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled time for the inspection, a cancellation fee shall be charged in an amount equivalent to one hour at the hourly rate.
