AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AMENDING CHAPTER 4.80 OF TITLE 4 OF THE SAN JOSE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD NEW PARTS RELATED TO **ESTABLISHMENT** THE OF THE BUILDING DEVELOPMENT FEE PROGRAM FUND. THE PLANNING DEVELOPMENT FEE PROGRAM FUND, THE CITYWIDE PLANNING FEE PROGRAM FUND, THE DEVELOPMENT FEE PROGRAM FUND, THE PUBLIC WORKS DEVELOPMENT FEE PROGRAM FUND, AND THE PUBLIC WORKS SMALL CELL PERMITTING FEE PROGRAM FUND

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions and requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, together with related State CEQA Guidelines and Title 21 of the San José Municipal Code (collectively, "CEQA"), the Director of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement has determined that the provisions of this Ordinance do not constitute a project, under File No. PP17-010 (City Organizational & Administrative Activities resulting in no changes to the physical environment) and File No. PP17-004 (Government funding mechanism or fiscal activity with no commitment to a specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San José is the decision-making body for this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, this Council has reviewed and considered the "not a project" determination under CEQA prior to taking any approval actions on this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANJOSE:

Monies in the Building Development Fee Program Fund shall be used to pay for the

cost of administration and enforcement of the permits issued under Title 24 of the San

José Municipal Code.

4.80.4440 <u>Interest</u>

Interest which accrues from monies in the Building Development Fee Program Fund

shall be credited to this Fund.

SECTION 2. A new Part is added to Chapter 4.80 of Title 4 of the San José Municipal

Code, to be numbered, entitled and to read as follows:

Part 73

Planning Development Fee Program Fund

provided under Titles 13, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 23 of the San José Municipal Code.

4.80.4470 Expenditures

Monies in the Planning Development Fee Program Fund shall be used to pay for the

cost of administration and enforcement of the permits and approvals issued and

services provided under Titles 13, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 23 of the San José Municipal

Code.

4.80.4480 Interest

Interest which accrues from monies in the Planning Development Fee Program Fund

shall be credited to this Fund.

SECTION 3. A new Part is added to Chapter 4.80 of Title 4 of the San José Municipal

Code, to be numbered, entitled and to read as follows:

Part 74

Citywide Planning Fee Program Fund

4.80.4490 Citywide Planning Fee Program Fund Established

There is hereby created and established the "Citywide Planning Fee Program Fund."

4.80.4500 Source of Monies

The source of monies budgeted and accounted for in the Citywide Planning Fee

Program Fund shall be the portion of fees paid for permits and approvals issued and

services provided under Titles 13, 18, 19, 20, 21, and 23 of the San José Municipal

Code that is allocated to the Citywide Planning Fee as specified in the resolution of the

City Council.

4.80.4510 Expenditures

Monies in the Citywide Planning Fee Program Fund shall be used to pay for the cost of

maintaining an updated General Plan, San José Zoning Code, GIS/data analytics,

urban design, historic preservation and other citywide plans and policies to allow

development and new construction to occur consistent with the City's development

policies and community objectives.

4.80.4520 Interest

Interest which accrues from monies in the Citywide Planning Fee Program Fund shall

be credited to this Fund.

Code, to be numbered, entitled and to read as follows:

Fire Development Fee Program Fund

Program Fund shall be the fees paid for permits issued and the services provided under

Chapter 17.12 of Title 17 of the San José Municipal Code.

4.80.4550 Expenditures

Monies in the Fire Development Fee Program Fund shall be used to pay for the cost of

administration and enforcement of the permits issued and services provided under

Chapter 17.12 of Title 17 of the San José Municipal Code.

4.80.4560 Interest

Interest which accrues from monies in the Fire Development Fee Program Fund shall

be credited to this Fund.

SECTION 5. A new Part is added to Chapter 4.80 of Title 4 of the San José Municipal

Code, to be numbered, entitled and to read as follows:

Part 76

Public Works Development Fee Program Fund

4.80.4570 Public Works Development Fee Program Fund Established

There is hereby created and established the "Public Works Development Fee Program"

Fund."

4.80.4580 Source of Monies

The source of monies budgeted and accounted for in the Public Works Development

Fee Program Fund shall be the fees paid for permits and approvals issued and the

services provided under Titles 13, 14, 15, 17, 19, 20, 21 and 27 of the San José

Municipal Code.

4.80.4590 Expenditures

Monies in the Public Works Development Fee Program Fund shall be used to pay for

the cost of administration and enforcement of the permits and approvals issued and

services provided under Titles 13, 14, 15, 17, 19, 20, 21 and 27 of the San José

Municipal Code.

4.80.4600 Interest

Interest which accrues from monies in the Public Works Development Fee Program

Fund shall be credited to this Fund.

SECTION 6. A new Part is added to Chapter 4.80 of Title 4 of the San José Municipal

Code, to be numbered, entitled and to read as follows:

Part 77

Public Works Small Cell Permitting Fee Program Fund

4.80.4610 Public Works Small Cell Permitting Fee Program Fund Established

There is hereby created and established the "Public Works Small Cell Permitting Fee

Program Fund."

4.80.4620 Source of Monies

The source of monies budgeted and accounted for in the Public Works Small Cell

Permitting Fee Program Fund shall be fees paid to the City by telecommunication

companies in connection with the Department of Public Works' review and approval of

the installation of small cell and fiber optic telecommunication facilities on property

owned by the City, including without limitation to, streetlights, traffic lights and rooftops.

4.80.4630 Expenditures

Monies in the Public Works Small Cell Permitting Fee Program Fund shall be used to

pay for the cost of review and approval of the plans and specifications and inspection of
