### **RECOMMENDATION**

Forward a recommendation to the City Council to approve a grant for the following school to support Willow Glen Education Foundation.

### **BACKGROUND**

Pursuant to City Council Expenditure and Reimbursement Policy, Policy Number 0-38, Section K "Grants", Item 6, "Any contribution to an organization proposed by a Council member who is a member of that organization must be approved in advance by the City Council.

Approval is requested to expend \$5,000 from the budgeted District 6 Community Outreach allocation to support the Willow Glen High School Foundation. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, they were unable to host their largest fundraiser of the year, Tasting and Auction 2020. The Foundation provides funds to inspire, promote, and bolster academic achievement and cultural enrichment of all students.
