### **RECOMMENDATION**

Forward a recommendation to the City Council to approve a grant for the following school to support Hoover Middle School PTSA

### **BACKGROUND**

Pursuant to City Council Expenditure and Reimbursement Policy, Policy Number 0-38, Section K "Grants", Item 6, "Any contribution to an organization proposed by a Council member who is a member of that organization must be approved in advance by the City Council.

Approval is requested to expend \$10,000 from the budgeted District 6 Community Outreach allocation to support the goals of the Hoover Middle School PTSA to build positive community for students, teachers and families through such programs as campus beautification, teacher and staff development, and extra-curricular activities for students (speech and science clubs, sports, field trips).
