Dear Cpuc,
This is my first time addressing, the Cpuc.
I may lack a certain depth, of knowledge. But I have been trying to follow, a hopeful, transition period, in Northern California.
As for decades now, many good people, have been patiently studying, how to create a decent future, with humanistic ideas & studies, towards positive, sustainable, local community energy practices.
Meanwhile, for the last several, PG&E, seems to have focused, on a new level, of economic infrastructure building & development, with controlled fire use.
It has felt like a harbinger, if not the impetus itself, for the current, world wide Covid-19 pandemic.
It is this sort of work & thinking, that invariably leads to, unstable, unpeaceful, and disorganzed, policy decision making.

The ACLU Surveillance and Technology Ordinance, is a part of a series, of guidelines, studies, and legal precedents, from the ACLU, the state of California, and the UN, among others.

It is how good civil rights & civil protection practices, can help everyday people & their local govt., work towards, more open and shared practices.

Interestingly, its efforts, towards, peace, shared oversight, and open, democratic practices, can bring organization, efficiency, consensus building, and an enjoyment in learning, for all sides.

These are the ideas, of decent minded, long-term stability.

There are the ideas, of positive sustainability, consensus building and good communication, between a community and its govt.

And that can allow ourselves, better choices, in how to work out of and leave, the incredibly unstable ways, of shock doctrine, disaster capitalism practices.

I hope the CPUC, and PG&E, can review, good accountability ideas, guidelines, examples, and legal precedents, this summer.

And realize, that at this time, there are important choices, in how to organize, our better human principles & ideals.

And in how, to better balance the questions, of long term, positive sustainability, for everyday people, their community, their local govt., and life on this planet.

These are, a set of ideas & practices, that are intended to work with, everyday people, their communities, and their local govt.


From this, a natural, collective care, at the local level, is meant to develop, a more decent reasoning, from national leaders.
