RECOMMENDATION

City Council adopt resolution proclaiming black lives matter in alignment with Council Policy 0-11, Council Resolution Policy. Place attached resolution on the June 30, 2020 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

In the face of recent national events involving the death of George Floyd and protests across the country, a light has been shed on a deeper issue in America: systemic racism. It is real and it is built into every level of our society in ways that might surprise us all.
