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# CAMP SAN JOSÉ STRONG - OUTREACH

## **Multi-Lingual Outreach Efforts**

- 23 food distribution locations
- Emailed 10,000 customers with children ages of 5-12
- Flash Reports, Next Door and social media outlets

## **Scholarship Data**

- 58% enrolled in Session 1 (239/412 campers)
- 61% enrolled in Session 2 (292/478 campers)

## **Registration and Scholarship Support**

- 8 locations open for support with evening and weekend hours
- Mobile registration provided:
  - Library Express Pickup locations
  - Valley Palms Food Distribution

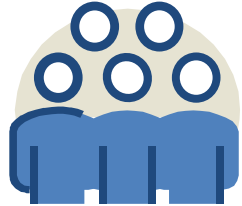

# Supporting Families & Childcare Providers Impacted by COVID-19

- **\$1M in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding available for childcare**
  - For children 0-5 years old
  - Funds to subsidize childcare for low-income families impacted by COVID-19
- **\$ 2.5M in Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) available to support childcare providers**
  - Specifically for Family Childcare Providers
  - Funds to subsidize loss of income due to COVID-19





# Early Education Services

Children 0-5 and their Caregivers

ENTERING SCHOOL READY  
TO LEARN AND SUCCEED



- Live virtual interactive storytimes via Zoom every weekday: **16K+** views, with **500+** children & caregivers
- Virtual preschool programming via Zoom every weekday: **250+** children & caregiver participants
- **150+** virtual storytimes in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Mandarin Chinese, Hindi, & Russian
- **20K+ views** of virtual Wee Connect series & Our City Storytime series
- **131+** caregivers registered for Ready4K, a text messaging system for caregivers of children ages 0-8

# Summer Learning: June 1 – July 31, 2020

- Virtual literacy program
- Coordinated with affordable housing locations
  - 25 readers EAH Markham Plaza
  - 75 readers EAH Delmas Park
- Coordinated with PRNS Camp San José Strong
  - 400 plus campers @ 23 locations
  - 1,300 book prizes
