**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE WOMEN'S EQUALITY DAY AND WOMEN'S  
SUFFRAGE CENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARY COMMUNITY EVENT  
SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 AS A CITY COUNCIL  
SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT  
DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

## **RECOMMENDATION**

1. Approve recognition of the Women's Equality Day and Women's Suffrage Centennial Anniversary on Wednesday, August 26, 2020 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the Tuesday, August 25, 2020 Council Agenda for action.

## **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Women's Equality Day and the Women's Suffrage Centennial Anniversary will be recognized on Wednesday, August 26, 2020 and sponsored by Councilmember Arenas. This special event celebrates women's achievements of the ongoing fight for gender equality and commemorates the centennial anniversary of the ratification of the 19th Amendment which guarantees women's constitutional right to vote.

## **ANALYSIS**

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Arenas will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 8, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
